

## Spitfire Brooch from 1940s



Spitfires for No. 164 Argentine-British Squadron (formed in Peterhead, Scotland during 1942) were purchased from donations made by the British community living in Argentina. My mother, Phyllis Penny, bought this brooch when living in Buenos Aires in the 1940s.

“Approved by BCC” on the inside and back of the box refers to the British Chamber of Commerce - an organisation that still supports trade and investment between Argentina and the UK.
